Kangding

Arrive at Chengdu Meeting in

Chengdu, the most important town of SICHUAN. transfer to the Hotel and visit the Tibetan market.

Chengdu/Ya'an/Kangding (2616m)

Leave Chengdu for Kangding in the morning. Tibetan highway through Ya'an city. Ya'an, is the starting point of the Sichuan-Tibet stretch of the Teahorse Road. Those trading activities went on for centuries. Overnight in Kangding







Kangding to bamei (3420m)

Visit Lhagang Monastery one of Kham's most sacred gompas. Through fantastic landscape, you could see the nomadic and local Tibetan houses. Overnight at Bamei, in the sungold Hotel, A nice Tibetan guesthouse. View on Stupa.



Day 4: Tawu

morning visit Garther monastery which is built by 7th Dali Lama; afternoon drive to Tawu, overning here in Tibetan family guesthouse, visit local stupa





Tawu à Kanze (3310m)

drive to Kanzi via Drago county, stop to have lunch, sightseeing the town of Drago county, continuous to kanzi on the way visit Jury monastery.

Dzongsar

drive to Pelyul, fantastic nomad's landscape, take picnic lunch at nomadic camp. Visit Yachen monastery which is one of the biggest retreat center in Tibet, then continue to Pelyul which is a pretty Tibetan town with the Ding-chu river running through it ; if the time permit, visit Pelyul monastery

drive to Dzongsar via Katock monastery

Dzongsar and Dorphu valley

Day 9 à 14: Dzongsar

Stay in traditional village of Dzongsar. Accommodation in Tibetan family or free in house. Trek in Dorphu valley into nomadic camp. Visit the Buddhist retreat centre

Day 9 à Day 11	 3 days in Dzongsar : Height between 3600 and 4000 m on average. Stay in traditional village of Dzongsar, Accommodation in Tibetan family or free in house. Visit of Dzongsar College, well-known as one of the best college in Tibet.
	Visit of Tibetan medicine house, Tangkha painting house and other traditional art of Dzongsar.
	walking around Dzongsar without any technical difficulties Discovery of the Tibetan life of the farmer.
	Visit of Dzongsar monastery and Meshu valley.
	Have tea, yogurt and Tsampa with so great Tibetan family.



3 days into the heart of Tibetan world and into the daily traditional life of nomadic people.

3 days in Dorphu Valley :

3 Days of walking without any technical difficulties.

Height between 3600 and 4000 m on average.

Stages from 4 to 6 hours of walking.

Accommodation in camp mostly situated in nomad's land, Porterage assured by yaks or horses.

Simple meal with local and traditional products.

Discovery of the Tibetan life of the nomads, their herds of yaks and horses.

Have tea and the tsampa in families nomads.

Along the road visit the Buddhist retreat centre

Day 15: Tawu	Dzongsar à Kanzi Return towards Chengdu via Kanzi.
Day 16: Damba	Kanzi à Danba Return by Danba, center of the Tibetan Gyaron.
Day 17: Chengdu	Danba explore Danba. see the holy mountain called Murdo, the traditional Tibetan houses and the Bonpo monasteries.
Day 18 : Chengdu	<mark>Danba à Chengdu</mark> Last night in Chengdu

Accommodation: Chengdu : standard hotel Chengdu/Dzongsar: Night in basic, traditional Tibetan guesthouse. Accommodation in family or free in house in Dzongsar,

Pique-nique or meal in family or traditional restaurant

Trekking Dorphu Valley

Stages from 4 to 6 hours of walking between 3600 and 4000 m.

Camp during the trek into Dorphu valley.

Transport of luggage: horse or yak. You carry only your personal thing.

Food during the camp: Traditional and make with local products.

Tibetan guide, driver and local team during the trek Group : 8 or 10 persons
